Curved synthetic red ceiling over us. One or two black constructions with straight black walls, there is a ladder to get up on top of the right-side object, and railings around of straight lines that extend a bit further out than being against the wall surface. The ground has brown and gray colors and is not smooth, the ground has many bumpy gray humps across it. There is a large brown stone-like item somewhere. There appear to be curvy gray asphalt roads, one which splits to go around to the back-left around the building. There is a short raised wall alongside at least one part of the asphalt road, along the top of this short raised wall goes a smooth curvy railing top which ends with a soft blunt shape. There is a roof or balcony up top on the left-side construction which extends outward from the dimensions of the building itself.

3:47 PM I have created one decoy PDF under a random file name. Note: The first decoy I had generated, I accidentally saw part of the first letters of its file name during the saving process so I never saved it to a PDF and generated a new Wikimedia random file as the decoy. I did not look at or save the intended first decoy.

Matching: My report matches strongly to the one with the two brown potatoes, as the brown potato that I thought it was was the first initial impression that came upon seeing the target signal. Result: The file with the palm tree was generated first at 3:33 PM and was the inteded target, the file with the brown potato shapes was generated second at 3:47 PM and is the decoy. This session indicates that switching took place, although I recognize the roofs and the red slide and somewhat red border shape in the background of the target image, so merging may have happened also or instead.

Outcome: I chose the wrong image of the two.
