I have made it into a PDF with a random unknown file name, the name of the target is still on the PDF so I have to open them carefully covering most of the screen to not see the image file names on the PDFs. The decoy was made without problem. I will do the matching, no delay was anywhere.

Matching: I am able to do the matching and the target identity has not been compromised. "Traffic" was a significant key phrase throughout my RV. I will match my report to the image with the trains and cars parking lot.

Outcome: I chose the correct image.

Discussion: Is switching, merging, or fail, suspected in this session? "Traffic" was significant, the stop sign, the airplane, the airport waiting room with lots of chairs, I rarely have this kind of a theme it is not a standard "go-to" impression or theme during my RVs. I am happy with the representation of traffic on this target image, I am happy with the correlation. Switching can therefore not be suspected, I looked at the decoy image and imagine that I would have perceived the arches, as well as not had some of the impressions that I did have, so I cannot suspect switching here. How about merging? I have no reason to suspect merging either. I find the house rooftops (with the dash lines) in the target image. How about a fail session? I find that the target image does represent the impressions that I was having of "traffic", even though these are two other kinds of traffic not air traffic, we have trains and cars.
