Main element seems to be a human, emphasis is on its head and face above, the human stands. The human has black boots with a black flap at the backs of the boots. Some sort of metal hat is seen, it feels like a couple of hundred years old costume or military or knight gear, the object behind the standing human was a saber like blade. The several holes are recurring, first seen on a white sleeve of the human, then on the blade, then on the curved gray-black platform that the human is standing on. It feels like we could also have a statue of a man, some ceremonial man in war costume but it feels older. The arched platform also appears vertical, and this shape is several times recurring. On the other side of one such object was the face as drawn, but this face actually faces into-page and would not be seen from our vantage point. The chin and jaw region of the man is most important in emphasis, drawn as insert on the top right. There is a ceiling above us, and the ceiling is arched curved convex upward, either indoors, outdoors, or both indoors and outdoors. An open doorway of that same arched shape is to the right. Walls with at least two windows of that shape are into-page, and the wall itself appears dark brown made of wood. It feels and looks like the 1600's, like Spain, but now I am perhaps only speculating and labeling.

Target PDF, decoy PDF, and matching will be done without any delay in between.

Source of error: While saving the target PDF, I accidentally saw that part of the file name, in the internet browser tab, contains the word "Ball" or "Ball and", furthermore while working to name the PDF file with the random word I saw that it had "m" or perhaps "more", whether part of original file name or random file name I do not know. I will attempt to open both PDFs and to not see any file names of images in PDFs and file names of PDFs, if that is possible.

I managed to open the two PDFs without seeing their file names (by only seeing the PDF icon on the right, in the folder they are in, and covering the screen to not see their file names that are written to the right). I also managed to cover part of the screen and to carefully view the two images without seeing their file names anywhere. I have now seen the two images, the images managed to stay fully blind, and I have chosen the image of the man as the match to my report.

Matching: The image of the man is a great match to my report, since the session showed me that the target was a human and was showing me the face and chin and jawline as main emphasis. The belt that I drew may be from the belt on the bowtie.

Outcome: I chose the correct image, the target was the image of the man. I suspect possible merging because I had the metal hat, as well as metal saber sword, however the indication of merging is small enough, mainly since the shapes from the decoy are not the rounded shapes that I was having but show more angular shapes, so merging is only slightly suspected. In normal protocol RV, and any protocol RV, I tend to be very good nowadays at least to pick out humans and have become good at describing humans.

The word "Ball" does appear in the target image name (which I did not see during matching so it did not ruin the matching for me) but when I had seen it accidentally earlier, I had assumed "ball" to mean a round spherical object, but here on the target image I would assume now in hindsight that it refers to a ball like an event with nice clothes and dancing.
