Title Roman Toilet Set Hanger
Description

English: A Roman copper alloy chatelaine (manicure or toilet set hanger). The main body of the hanger is rectangular in form with a narrowly tapered triangular section. The hanger has a teardrop-shaped suspension loop with single circular perforation projecting from the upper edge and a single perforated teardrop-shaped lug (one incomplete) projecting from each of the two lower corners of the main body of the hanger which would have held the axis bar from which the toilet implements (e.g. tweezers, nail cleaner, ear spoon and pick) were suspended. The lower edge of the rectangular body, above the now missing axis bar, has a lengthways semi-cylindrical groove which would have enabled better rotational movement of the implements on the axis bar. None of the toilet implements were found with the hanger. The front surface of the hanger is decorated with six rectangular cells arranged in a row with a single lengthways groove above and below. The remnants of red enamel, possibly of two different alternating shades of red, are present in the cells. The reverse has four unevenly spaced lengthways grooves running from side-to-side. The object is in good condition with a rich mid-green patina.

Hangers of this type are typically dated AD. c.43-200 (1st - 2nd century).
