I would have enjoyed exploring this target site more, and had plenty more leads to work on, but the amount of work into sessions needs to be kept at constant throughout this experiment.

Black curved bricks path is main element, it is low and has two low raised walls on either side, with a black narrow path that goes in between the two low raised walls. Arched door opening at the far end into-page, another similar is further below in the foreground. Trees are just above and nearby also further below. Water was seen to the left not far down from the top of a low wall. A large white building as drawn, it was not full at the top, as drawn with black. A human is here, also a big D-shaped (flipped 90 degrees to lie downward) is seen as if the path leads to it and water flows out of it, not really a human mouth but reminds my logical mind of a mouth. Red flags, and yellow flags, are seen repeatedly. Many little like decorative paper or kite flags along a string, small ones, this all reminds me of the great wall in China. A human is here and was seen sitting on the wall but was also seen with its arms spread out wide and having a huge kite construction attached to itself like two red spread out wings. I thoroughly enjoyed this target and it presented impressions clearly, impressions, elements, and target signal were all wonderful to work with.

I now see the target, then generate and see a decoy, and no self-matching in this protocol. Comment at feedback: The target is a map and it is one of those kinds of images that do not lend well for remote viewing, at least not with my current skill set. Interesting, now that I see the decoy, I had a suspicion that I may have gone to the decoy instead, but I am not entirely sure of it. I seem to recognize features from the decoy image from what I was experiencing during the RV. Ah yes, even the large white silo building is there on the decoy, this reduces some of the healthy doubt that I held on having remote viewed from the decoy, I now see a clearer connection to the decoy.
