There is a lot of activity and movement. Things are being carried. It goes very fast and quickly the movement, but that is how they move, they are not trying to be quick about it. They stay away from the heat or otherwise they would get fried and roasted and die. They are carrying boards to place them, and their own bodies do not weigh much. They can see quite clearly. They spit with their saliva to build things. They don't walk very long marches very far. They can walk on the boards that they have built with. They talk with each other with little clicks, and then they know where to go to find water in the shade under ground. They do not ever hurry to get there, or walk over someone else's boards, everything must go in great order. They stay away from the hot midday sun, and then at other times it is time for their dinner, and they go and eat together, but they always leave their droppings somewhere else, for the dewdrops that they drink. (Ok logic OR RV has taken me to termites obviously, since logic knows what the search words are. I have to see if I can get something else from the target than this.)

It is very busy, lifeforms. They are looking for sugar, something that tastes sweet to eat. They get it from a nectar. They are carrying thin boards.

Probe one of those boards: It is being dragged away with its jaws. It pulls on it, rather than pushes on it. It was really interesting being inside an insect termite colony, it feels really neat and at home for me to be there. They never walk over someone else's boards. They do not step over someone else. They stay away from the hot midday sun, and then (after the midday noon sun) it is time to go and get something to eat (they eat in the afternoon). They use their spit and saliva to build things with.

Probe a board: They make sure not to put too much weight down onto a placed board so that no one who is under it would get crushed, they make sure not to injure each other. They also stay away from birds, birds secrete a fragrant oil from their feathers which smells bitter, they sense that smell and go hide away. They also stay away from rain and waterdrops, and they carry their younglings away to hide them from water. They also stay away from certain types of mushrooms that want to grow on their walls, as those would make them feel dry and go dizzy if they ate them. They take good care of each other. They also stay warm when it gets cold, and they huddle together and talk and communicate, and they give each other their spit in kisses across the jaws, this kiss contains all their information. They can climb rather high up, but they prefer to not, because they do not want

to fall down, and they also do not like to be exposed, they do not want to risk getting burned by the heat of sun. They use their spit to build great things out of their saliva, and they also feed some of it to their young so that they can have the microbes. The droppings are carried to somewhere else but away from their nest, because it smells bad and otherwise confuses their senses, so it urges them to carry it away, it is also used as a decoy to send some predators away to someplace else.

Ok this is a serious termites impression, logic must have got something to do with this. I will try again from the target to see if I can get something else.

I am going somewhere. They are climbing on narrow boards. They move really fast but it does not feel so fast for them.

Locate one of the lifeforms and investigate it: They use their saliva and spit to communicate with.

Ok I am going to say that this is all about termites, and if the target is not termites then we can say that logic had a lot of fun doing all of this for me. It feels as if I am really visiting termites, so logic may have brought me to termites even if it was not the target it feels as if I am RVing them. I will not make a drawing because it is so busy with so many little things. I look forward to the targets where logic will not know the search words.

I did not make a drawing. The target image is of yellow entrance signs to Legoland Florida, there are palm trees in the background, no termites. I blame all inaccuracy in RV on logic (or some on "my" mistakes as the conscious person), so it seems that logic may have taken the most interesting, the most active of the search words, and gone there, getting excited and carried away and forgetting that the target is the first picture that shows up. Something as active as termites may have simply been irresistible. They say in mainstream RV that the mind likes to go to places with lots of interesting things and activity, entropy they call it.

It is important that I not get frustrated. This is an experimental protocol, and also a flawed one since these are not fully blind targets and to some extent logic is standing in its fenced in field and it can see that the gate has been opened for it to roam around, it knows it is supposed to stay where it is but it just can't resist going to something as entropy filled and exciting as termites. I had a great fun time exploring the termites and the experience was at least that I was really there, but whether it was just imagination concocted by logic I cannot distinguish if it was.

I remind myself that it is actually valuable to run into a series of fails while testing out different protocols. During normal blind RV targets, I rarely get a complete fail such as this one, so they are rare occurrences in my RV and are interesting to study for that reason.

The target image does have two yellow boards that have been "placed", but I consider that irrelevant to start to try to find some connection, because my report was termites.

I want to say that the session went fast and was "hectic" in the same way that is typical of "false history", which is when logic (I blame logic) starts to construct an ELABORATE story with LOTS of

details and it goes fast and without pauses and I write a lot. Typically my false histories have taken me to ancient historical sites such as ancient Romans or ancient Egypt would be typical for those, but this one was also an elaborate story.

It was an interesting experience, and I set aside my initial frustration at having had this kind of fail and I consider this session as valuable and interesting. I am happy anyway. In spite of a possible correlation from the two yellow boards which was an emphasis in my history of the termites placing and building with boards and planks (I should have investigated that element more), I want to give this session an F. Or possibly a C, I will need to think about this. Actually I could have and should have started to draw the boards, then that would have correlated to at least a C.
