I am happy with the correlation, since as I summarized on the checklist I emphasized on the pipes and the lamps and if there is water flowing inside the pipes we do not see on this picture since we are outside of those pipes on the picture. I like the checklist idea because I get to summarize concisely, I most of all like the last question on the checklist where I get to say what the judge is to look for in an image for the matching.

This target photograph IS suitable for an RV judge matching. I will now generate two more target images. The images must only qualify as suitable RV images to be chosen. Or no, I must NOT generate the other two images right now because that could put this at risk of displacement! The two non-target images for a matching will be generated later.

ELEMENTS

3. IE. A gurgling and gushing of blue water, a thick stream of water that rises up on its top as if washing down over something as it runs forward.

T. The water goes down into a hollow space.

3. IE. One tiny red dish or plate, but unusual edges to be a plate, it is floating.

T. Several long brown hairs that are thick or wide but light-weight, run downward from around the bottom of this dish. There is a yellow lamp above the red dish. Through the red dish a tunnel continues down, hence the red dish does not have a floor to it.

IE. There is talking taking place here.

IE. We are inside of a tunnel, the inner tunnel walls have several horisontal-plane etched in rings or grooves so it is not a smooth tunnel wall.

T. A thick pipe but in a horisontal alignment.

P. There are lamps in here! Several lamps along the ceiling.

IE. There is a "beep" sound heard.

IE. Motion or travel or direction, the water flushes down into the tunnel and continues along under the ground level toward the left.

3. IE. A yellow half-circle in the background at ground level (ground level is before the fall down the tunnel) with its flat side horisontal and the arched half-circle upward.

T. A buzzing is felt and heard when this one is approached to be poked.

P. We have to move past it toward the left. It feels like mud on its top when patted on. A water flows past its front side.

2. SE. There are several yellow lamps along the ceiling of the horisontal tunnel, not right along the very top line but a bit on the into-page side, evenly spaced about three to five lamps at least.

SE. Several long but thin light-weight strips that hang down from around the bottom of the red dish. T. Feels sturdy, not flowing and not easy to brush aside.

SE. It smells here like a sewer or like a waste water.

SE. The target is a water slide!
